The National Neurotrauma Society is soliciting proposals for scientific sessions for the 2019 Annual Symposium.

The theme for this year's conference is: *Bridging Gaps in Understanding the Neurobiology and Neurotechnology of Function after Neurotrauma*. All proposals will be reviewed by members of the Program Planning Committee. Decisions regarding acceptance of sessions will be rendered by **October 17, 2018**.

Proposals that will have the highest priority are those with a focus on FUNCTION. The concept of function is meant to be broad and has application to basic, translational, and clinical science. Relationships to cellular function and neurotransmission, functional endpoints with experimental model systems, treatment effects on function, functional assessment, and disability and community integration are some examples of responsive topics.
